Dear Parents and Carers,

I hope that you had a lovely break over Christmas and its been lovely to welcome everyone back to school for our first term of 2025!

The daily routine will remain the same, the children will arrive at the gate between 08:45 and 08:55 before taking part in their morning task, English, maths, guided reading, spelling and handwriting support lessons in the morning. Other curriculum subjects will be taught in the afternoon. All subject overview pages for Geography, Science, RE, Music, PSHE, Art and Computing are available on the website. After half term we will rotate to History, Spanish and D&T.

Our PE days this term will be **Monday** and **Thursday**. The children should wear black jogging bottoms or shorts, white t-shirts and their navy blue PE hoodie. They can continue to wear black trainers everyday as we are regularly active. The children should be wearing their full uniform on non-PE days. The children should bring their **bookbags** to school everyday and these are stored in their trays. Message books and super star reading records should also be in school everyday. Messages regarding any issues in school will be sent home in message books with all other communication going through admin.

In **English**, we will be studying the texts of Grimm's fairy-tales, Monsters: An Owner's Guide, The Great Fire of London and An Interview with a Tiger this term. **Maths** will see us finish our learning about multiplication & division before moving onto fractions and measurement sequences such as money and length & perimeter.

Our Around the World challenge and spelling tests will both continue to be on a Monday. Spellings for the half term have been emailed. The children should continue reading at home regularly as this has a huge impact on their progress with reading.

Thank you for your continuing support with fundraising, trips and events. As ever, we have lots planned for this term and details will be shared with you soon!
