Class 2- Ms Rae

Class 2 started a new unit of English this week based on the book *Outdoor Wonderland*. We have been looking at the features that instructions include including imperative verbs and ensuring steps are in chronological order, as well as how some instructions have pictures and illustrations to help the reader.

We were fortunate to have a visit from Mr Slocombe again this week, this time teaching us art, where we worked with Class 1 to create an abstract scene in the style of artist Hundertwasser.

In maths we have continued looking at addition and subtraction with Year 3 and Year 4 focusing on adding four-digit number across a ten and Year 5 and Year 6 looking at common multiples.

We have continued doing tag rugby in PE and are approaching the end of our art units with some incredible abstract self portraits that were created by Year 3 and Year 4.

Today sees the start of Forest School for Year 3, 4 and 5 whilst Year 6 are staying in school to visit separately later on in the school year.

Families with children in Class 1 who are eligible are encouraged to apply as the funding is in addition to Universal Free School Meals!

If your circumstances have changed and you are now in receipt of one or more of the following:

- Universal credit (provided you have a net income of £7400 or less)
- Income support
- Income-based jobseekers' allowance
- Income-related employment and support allowance
- Support under Part IV of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guaranteed element of state pension credit
- Child tax credit, provided that you are not also entitled to working tax credit and have an annual gross income of £16,190 or less

You may be eligible for pupil premium funding for Kings Nympton Primary School, which entitles your child/ren to receive Free School Meals.
